

40 YEARS OF ORGANIZED JUNIOR GOLF LEAGUES AT WANAKI

Wanaki Golf Course celebrates 40 years of organized junior golf leagues in 2018. Started in 1978, the very popular Wanaki Junior Golf League has ballooned from 30 players in the early years to an average of 250-300 junior golfers in most recent times.

This extremely popular program generally is full within 10 days of registration. Junior golfers from all areas of the County play in the league.

In addition to seven weeks of golf, all juniors receive food and beverage, prizes, golf balls, pre-season training, on course instruction, and a year-end tournament with cookout.

Complimenting the junior league, Wanaki also offers beginner junior lessons, clinics, and introduction to competitive golf seminars.

A very experienced and dedicated staff at Wanaki has made this program one of the largest and most successful in the area.

Many players who have participated in these programs have gone on to play High School Golf at the State Tournament level, Competitive Wisconsin amateur events, and college golf. A current PGA tour Professional named Mark Wilson also graced the fairways of Wanaki as a junior golfer.

Boys and girls of all ages have experienced the Wanaki Junior Program for 40 years and with golf being as popular as ever for youths, the programs will surely continue to grow.
