Moor Downs Golf Course – FootGolf Frequently Asked Questions

Fast Facts about the Program:

FootGolf will be added to Moor Downs Golf Course offerings starting June 15, 2015. The National Golf Foundation Consulting, Inc. (NGF) has seen dozens of courses in the Midwest and elsewhere introduce FootGolf as a way to encourage people to experience the golf course and enjoy a modified golf experience. FootGolf allows a course to diversify its property and create more revenues from its operations. Moor Downs is accredited by the American FootGolf League.

What is FootGolf?

FootGolf is the combination of golf and soccer played at your local golf course. It is played by kicking a soccer ball on a golf course with the objective of getting the ball into an oversized (21-inch in diameter) hole in the fewest amount of kicks. It's 99% golf, minus the equipment.

Where can I play?

Moor Downs Golf Course, 438 Prospect Ave, Waukesha.

How many holes do you play?

Moor Downs will have an 18-hole course, however you can play 9-holes if you choose.

How much does it cost per person to play a round of FootGolf?

What tee times are available for FootGolf?

FootGolf tee times are available anytime the golf course is open except during traditional golf league play. Please contact the Moor Downs clubhouse at (262) 548-7821 for further details on tee time availability.

Do we play at the same time as regular golfers?

There will be times where the groups are playing on the course at the same time. The pace of play for each group is about the same, with the FootGolfers being a bit quicker. We always remind all FootGolfers to observe normal golf etiquette at all time on the course.

How long does it take to FootGolf 18 holes?

We found that for a group of 4 players, it takes approximately 90 minutes.

Do I have to make a tee time?

No, a tee time is not required. However, we strongly recommend that you call the clubhouse at (262) 548-7821 in advance to book a tee time to ensure you and your group are able to get out during your desired time.

May I Play with any ball? Do I need a Soccer Ball to play?

FootGolf is played with a soccer ball (Reg. FIFA soccer ball #5 or #4). FootGolfers can bring their own soccer ball, however you can rent a ball for \$5.00.

I have never played golf, what do you do once you get to the golf course?

Players will need to check in at the pro shop counter within the clubhouse. At that time, staff will explain the process for getting started to play FootGolf.

How many people can play in a group?

Standard group size for golf applies. You can FootGolf as a single, twosome, threesome or foursome. Larger groups can tee off as foursomes one after another, depending on the tee sheet.

What is the dress code?

We allow FootGolfers to wear athletic clothing and footwear, but no tank tops and no cleats. Indoor soccer shoes or golf shoes are allowed.

Are there age restrictions to play at Footgolf?

There is no age restriction as long as your group keeps the pace of play with the other golfers.

Do you walk or use a cart?

Either. But it is actually quicker to walk because you are not hitting the ball hundreds of yards. Walking also encourages exercise and the endurance component of the game.

Do FootGolfers use the same greens and tees as the traditional golfer?

No, the greens and tees for FootGolf are completely separate from those of traditional golf. Not all FootGolf greens are located near the regular greens.
